176 Budget & Precept 2023-2024

The Clerk stated that a Community Council must calculate its budget requirement for a financial year in accordance with Section 50 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992 and issue a precept to the billing authority. The billing authority collects the precept (charge) on behalf of Town and Community Councils under Section 41 of the above Act.

Swansea Council has informed the Community Council that the Council Tax Base 2023-2024 for Llangyfelach has been calculated as **943** Band D equivalent properties.

The Finance Committee met on 8 December 2022 and recommended that:

- i) The Precept for 2023-2024 be set at £30,000.
- ii) The draft Budget 2023-2024 be approved.

Resolved that:

- 1) Swansea Council be informed that the Precept for 2023-2024 be set at £30,000.
- 2) The Budget 2023-2024 as outlined in Appendix A of the report be approved and adopted.
