195 Swansea Council Matters: Planning, Highways, Footpaths, Cycleways & Bridleways

i) Diversion Footpaths 89 and 90 in Llangyfelach

The Clerk referred to correspondence from Swansea Council seeking to divert the above footpaths to allow development to take place.

Most of footpath 89 will be retained on its original route, except for the southern section which will be extended and moved onto a new route through the development. It will then connect to new active travel routes, that will enable walkers to proceed through to Llangyfelach Road for the first time since 1954. This path is presently a dead end. Most of footpath 90 will be replaced by adopted roads and active travel routes through the development.

The footpaths will retain their junctions with Pen Plas Road at the same points as they do at present, and both footpaths will also connect to the adopted roads network in the development, enabling walkers to access Swansea Road on a new road.

Resolved that the footpath diversions be supported.



196 Training Plan

The Clerk stated that the Training Plan was adopted on 13 April 2023. It sets out the training requirements for Community Councillors and Staff. The monthly One Voice Wales, Planning Aid Wales and other relevant training schedules have been circulated. Councillors should regularly review their training requirements in line with the Training Plan & Training Matrix. To attend training, liaise with the Clerk.

197 Llangyfelach Ward Councillor Update

Councillor Mark Tribe, Llangyfelach Ward Councillor submitted a verbal report outlining his work within the Ward.

198 Presentation - Penllergaer Solar Farm

Jake Geczy of Elements Green gave a presentation on the Penllergaer Solar Farm Scheme. The Scheme is for a solar farm covering an area of circa 250 acres with a total capacity of 53MWp which would, in line with the Welsh government's target to meet 70% of its electricity needs from renewable sources by 2030, begin supplying low carbon energy to the national grid by August 2026.

199 Church Hall Defibrillator & Pedi Pads

The Clerk stated that a new defibrillator and Pedi Pads (Child sized pads) had been purchased from Heartbeat Trust UK. The new defibrillator and pads cost £1,130 and replace the previous defibrillator. The defibrillator cabinet will remain unlocked to save valuable minutes in the event of an emergency. The defibrillator will be managed on behalf of the Council by Heartbeat Trust UK. It has been registered on The Circuit.

Resolved that the update be noted.

200 Consider Requests for Grants & Donations

The Council stated that the Council had allocated £1,000 of its 2023-2024 budget to its Grants & Donations Policy.
