- 3) The PCSO be asked to assist with traffic and parking during the Christmas Fair.

Remembrance Sunday falls on 9 November 2025. The Chair of Council shall lay a Poppy Wreath on behalf of the Community Council.

Councillors discussed purchasing a pair of Unknown Tommy and Women in War Statues from the Royal British Legion Industries.
